2.798 HLC Distance Delivery Substantive Change Application Approval

The Higher Learning Commission (HLC) recognizes that change at institutions of higher learning is constant, and it supports institutional efforts to improve educational quality. Depending on the type of change an institution plans to make — expanding its academic offerings, opening a new location, changing its mission, etc. — it may be required to apply for prior HLC approval or notify HLC of the change.

When prior approval is required, the institution must submit an application describing the change. The application will be reviewed by HLC staff or peer reviewers (depending on the complexity of the change), and an HLC decision-making body will take final action to approve or deny the request. This process ensures that institutions continue to meet HLC's standards as they evolve and grow.

As enrollment increases in the area for online classes, Alpena Community College would like to obtain approval from the Higher Learning Commission to provide distance learning in all associates degrees, programs, and certificates.

In order to complete the substantive change application, the Higher Learning Commission requires internal approval by the board of trustees.

Therefore, the following resolution is proposed:

That the Alpena Community College Board of Trustees supports the submission of a Distance Delivery Substantive Change Application to the Higher Learning Commission for approval to provide distance education in all associate degrees, programs and certificates.

2.799 Tuition Rate for Fiscal Year 2022

Alpena Community College receives revenue from three main sources: appropriations from the State of Michigan, a 2.5 mills assessment on properties in the Alpena Public Schools district, and tuition and fees. In recent years, revenue from state appropriations and property taxes have been limited due to downward economic influences in Michigan. In order to maintain a balanced budget, Alpena Community College looks first to managing expenses wherever feasible. Secondly, the College looks to bring in additional revenue to maintain high standards of service to students and community members.

The College is always mindful of the cost of education and its impact on students. There are a number of scholarship and grant opportunities available to students to help defray the cost of education, including a number of scholarships given annually by the ACC Foundation.

For Fiscal Year 2022, College officials are proposing to increase tuition approximately 3%; with no tuition increase for FY 2021, this modest increase is expected to partially offset a 7.7% decline in enrollment for FY 2021.

ACC continues to be highly affordable to students especially compared to four-year institutions, and continues to provide great value to all in Northeast Lower Michigan. ACC's costs are also competitive with similar community colleges who enjoy better property tax revenues.

Therefore, the following resolution is proposed:

The Alpena Community College Board of Trustees approves the following tuition rate for the 2022 fiscal year effective with Fall Semester 2021.

4.019 Financial Report

Monthly General Fund Revenue and Expense through February 2021 (Year to Year Actual Comparison)

- The property tax receipts of \$2,463,457 are \$473,464 more than those for February 2020, higher due to timing of receipts.
- Tuition/fee receipts of \$5,772,689 are \$306,153 less primarily due to lower than expected enrollments for Spring registrations.
- State aid is as expected.
- Federal revenue displays the entire \$2,435,600 in Paycheck Protection Program funding as recorded through February. The College has applied for the forgiveness portion of the program and awaiting determination.
- Instruction and Instructional Support are as expected for this time of year.
- Student services is as expected for this time of year due to the changeover in registrar from last year.
- Institutional Administration is higher as expected due to the addition of the Alumni Relations position, and changes in healthcare coverage.
- Physical plant is lower due to timing of payment to Alpena Police Department, lower overtime, and energy costs.
- All other expense areas are as expected for this time of year.
- Net income through the eighth month of the year shows as a gain of \$3,514,874, due to PPP funds recorded, reduced by lower than anticipated tuition and fee revenue.

Monthly General Fund Revenue and Expense through February 2021 (Budget to Actual Comparison)

- Supplies are lower due to the lower number of students and staff on campus.
- Travel is down compared to last year due to COVID 19 travel restrictions.
- Library Books & Equipment is down based on timing of acquisitions.
- All expense categories are in acceptable ranges for this stage of the year.

General Fund Month to Month Comparison through February 2021

- February property taxes were higher due to the timing of winter tax receipts.
- Faculty overload and other extra pays occur in February.
- Outside services was substantially up for the month because of \$78,250 of charges from Consumers Energy training.
- All other Month-to-Month comparisons are tracking as expected.
