Students enrolled in the Electrical System Technology Bachelor Program, who have earned greater than 60 credits towards the program, have increased loan maximums. The subsidized loan maximum is \$5,500 annually (based on eligibility). The annual loan maximums (for combined subsidized and unsubsidized loans) are \$7,500 for a Dependent student and \$12,500 for an Independent student (based on eligibility). Students enrolled in this program and requesting loan amounts greater than the above listed sophomore level must provide "My Progress" (from Self-Service through the MyACC Portal) along with this loan application.
