Complete Withdrawal (all courses W Grades) is Friday, December 9. For short courses (less than 16 weeks), please contact the Registrar's Office for drop/withdrawal dates.

Spring 2023 Early Registration for students began Monday, October 31. **Tuition is due by December 2.**

Fall Graduation Applications were due to the Registrar's Office by **Friday, October 7**. Graduation applications are available in the Registrar's Office or on Self-Service.

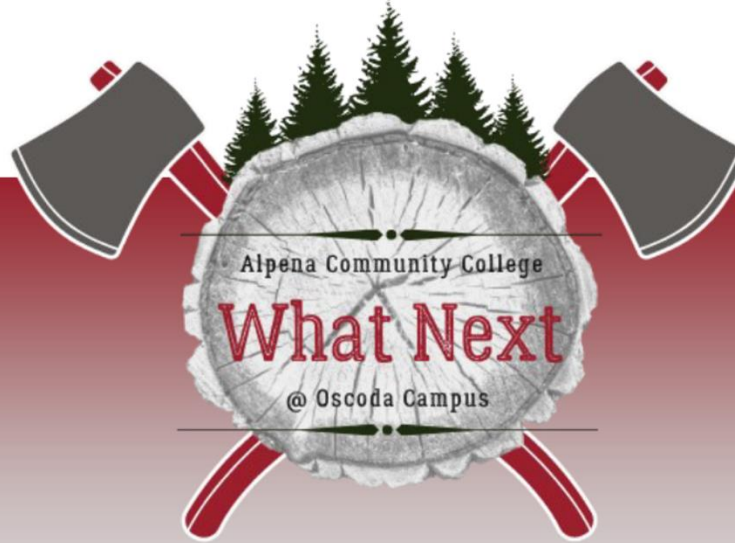
