2.861 Revision to Policy 5011, Tuition Waiver for Campus Activity Program Policy — First Reading

Alpena Community College traditionally incentivizes student-athletes with tuition waivers. The current Board Policy 5011, Tuition Waiver for Campus Activity Program Policy, sets the total amount of tuition waivers at 660 contact hours per year. With the addition of the new men's baseball team, there is now more demand for athletic tuition waivers.

In recognition of the additional need, ACC officials are proposing to increase the total number of tuition waiver contact hours to 780 per fiscal year. Following is a proposed breakdown of how the contact hours would be allocated by sport:

Following is the text of Policy 5011 modified to show the proposed change:

The Board of Trustees authorizes College officials to initiate procedures which will implement a program of tuition waivers in selected activity areas that will make available to designated key participants a waiver of tuition in an amount not to exceed 30 contact hours per year per student with a grand total of such waivers not to exceed 660 780 contact hours per fiscal period. In addition, this policy allows students a book and fee waiver only when the student's contact hours are covered by another source; the approval of these waivers will come from the Dean of Students and be based on established procedures. The book and fee waiver amounts will not exceed the equivalent amount allowed for contact hours. Annual progress reports will be provided.

Therefore, the following resolution is proposed:

The Alpena Community College Board of Trustees approves upon first reading changes to Policy 5011, Tuition Waiver for Campus Activity Program Policy.

2.862 Extension of Reversionary Interest of College, District Health Department No. 4 Project

In 2022 Alpena Community College officials and the Board of Trustees Property Subcommittee were approached by representatives of the Alpena County Board of Commissioners regarding the status of property located adjacent to Wilson Road that is currently the site of the District Health Department #4 building.

The property was conveyed by ACC to the County of Alpena in 1996 for the purpose of providing a location for the DHD4 building. The deed to the property contained a reverter clause which, among other things, determined that the property would revert to ACC on July 25, 2036. County board representatives approached ACC to determine the College's interest in extending the reverter clause. After discussion it was determined that extending the reverter clause for 30 years, to July 25, 2066, would be desirable by the County. ACC officials then worked with ACC attorney Karen Bennett to draft documents which would affect that change to the 1996 deed.

Following is the text of the resolution Karen Bennett has written for consideration by the ACC Board of Trustees.

WHEREAS, The County of Alpena is one of the constituent counties of District Health Department No. 4 (the "Health Department"), a "district health department" formed by the counties of Alpena, Cheboygan, Montmorency, and Presque Isle under Section 2415 of Act 368, P.A. 1978, as amended, for the purposes of providing essential public health services to residents of those counties; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 1996, the College conveyed certain lands described on Exhibit A (the "Site") to the County of Alpena by deed recorded at Liber 327 Pages 678-680, Alpena County records (the "College Deed",) a copy of which is attached hereto, for the purpose construction of a public health department building, to be leased to the Health Department to satisfy the urgent need of the Health Department and the County for a building to house medical and office facilities for the provision of health care and human services to residents of the County (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project was fully constructed and the College subordinated its interest to the lien of the mortgage financing for the construction of the Project, and the Health Department has continuously used and occupied the property, which now is in need of significant repairs and improvements; and

WHEREAS, the College Deed, expressly provides that it is subject to a reversionary interest held by the College, whereby the subject property and all improvements thereto will revert to the College upon the happening of certain events described in in the College Deed and shall revert to the College on the 25th day of July, 2036, in all events without any demand or further action on the part of the College; and

WHEREAS, the County of Alpena seeks to extend the date on which title to the subject property will revert reversion to the College in order to facilitate the ability of the County to make and finance needed repairs and improvements to the property and to continue to use and occupy the property, as improved; and WHEREAS, the College agrees that it is a benefit to the College and in the public interest to allow the County to continue to use, maintain and improve the property in order to preserve the economic viability of the subject property and serve the needs of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Board Chair is authorized and directed to execute and deliver an instrument, in the form approved by legal counsel for the College, modifying the reversionary interest held by the College to provide that the date on which title to and possession of the property shall revert to the College is extended for 30 years from July 25, 2036, to July 25, 2066, and further providing that title and possession of the property shall revert to the College in the event of the occurrence of one or more of the events set forth below, all of which are included in the College Deed:
 - a) The premises are not being used on a regular basis for functions of the Health Department No. 4 or any successor thereto or related health and human services functions of governmental or 501(c)(3) organizations.
 - b) The premises are being used for a purpose which is not permitted by applicable zoning ordinance governing the use of the premises as such ordinance exists from time to time (or duly authorized variance thereof).
 - c) Default of any mortgage on the premises and failure of the County of Alpena to cure such default and exercise by the College of its right to cure such default as set forth in any Subordination Agreement to which the College is a party.
- 2. The Board Chair is authorized and directed to execute and deliver such documents and instruments approved by legal counsel for the College as are reasonably necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution including a Subordination Agreement in a form acceptable to the College which subordinates the interest of the College in the real property described herein to the lien of any mortgage obtained by the County for the purpose of financing improvements to the property, provided that such subordination agreement permits but does not obligate the College to cure any default on the property, whereupon title and possession of the property shall revert to the College.
- 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

CONVEYS to the COUNTY OF ALPENA, a Michigan municipal corporation, whose address is 720 Chisholm Streeet, Alpena, Michigan 49707, those premises situated in the County of Alpena, State of Michigan, described on Exhibit A attached hereto, for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00).

Subject to easements and building and use restrictions of record, and the reversion rights of the Grantor set forth herein.

UNENCUMBERED TITLE TO AND EXCLUSIVE POSSESSION OF THE PREMISES (INCLUDING THE PROPERTY FINANCED BY BONDS TO BE ISSUED BY NHF SUB ALPENA, A MICHIGAN NONPROFIT CORPORATION, AND ANY ADDITIONS THERETO) SHALL IMMEDIATELY REVERT TO THE GRANTOR IN THE EVENT OF ANY OF THE OCCURRENCES DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPHS 1, 2, 3 OR 4 BELOW PROVIDED, HOWEVER, ABSENT THE OCCURENCE OF ONE OR MORE OF THE EVENTS DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPHS 1,2,3 OR 4, THE PREMISES SHALL REVERT TO THE GRANTOR ON THE 25TH DAY OF JULY, 2036, AND IN ALL EVENTS WITHOUT ANY DEMAND OR FURTHER ACTION ON THE PART OF THE GRANTOR:

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- 1. Commencement of the construction on the premises of an approximately 28,000 square foot building to house medical and office facilities for the provision of health care and human services to be rendered by District Health Department No. 4 and other governmental units and qualified tax exempt charitable organizations (the "Project"), does not commence prior to December 31, 1996, or completion of the construction of the Project does not occur prior to December 31, 1997, as evidenced by the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy by the appropriate governmental agency.
- The Project constructed on the premises is not being used on a regular basis for functions of District Health Department No. 4 (or any successor entity of District Health Department No. 4 providing substantially the same services), or related health and human service functions of governmental or Section 501(c) (3) organizations.
- 3. The premises are being utilized for a purpose which is not permitted by the applicable zoning ordinance governing the use of the premises as it exists from time to time (or a duly authorized variance therefrom).
- 4. Exercise of the Grantor's right to cure a default in the outstanding mortgage indebtedness on the premises following a default by the mortgagor, NHF SUB ALPENA, and the failure of the County of Alpena to cure such default, all as set forth in the Subordination Agreement among CB NORTH, a Michigan banking

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corporation, the COUNTY OF ALPENA and the GRANTOR, dated effective as of the date of this Deed.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE REVERSION RIGHTS OF THE GRANTOR HEREIN ARE SUBJECT AND SUBORDINATE TO THE CLAIMS OF THE GRANICR HEREIN ARE SUBJECT AND SUBORDINATE TO THE CLAIMS OF THE HOLDER OF THE BONDS (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY MORTGAGE INDEBTEDNESS) UNTIL THE INDEBTEDNESS REPRESENTED BY THE BONDS ISSUED ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF ALPENA FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT ON THE PREMISES ARE PAID IN FULL.

The consideration for this conveyance is less than \$100 and it is therefore, exempt from county real estate transfer tax pursuant to MCL 207.505(a) and State real estate transfer tax pursuant to MCL 207.526(1).

The preparer of this document has not conducted any examination of the title of the above described premises.

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4.073 Financial Report

Monthly General Fund Revenue and Expense through November 2022 (Year to Year Actual Comparison)

- The property tax receipts of \$610,035 are \$21,090 more than those for November 2021, as expected.
- Tuition/fee receipts of \$4,781,209 are \$101,315 less than last year at this time because of lower than expected enrollments thus far.
- State aid for the current year is \$1,245,392 because of the normal start month of October, regular appropriations are \$38,000 more than last year. Additionally, \$81,364 was received for personal property tax, approximately \$9,000 less than last year. The College also received a one-time payment of \$225,700 last year. These differences total to around a negative \$196,400.
- There are no HEERF funds available this year.
- Instruction is lower due to a couple of faculty retirements.
- OIT's increase is due to planned wage increases and timing of software purchases.
- Instruction support is elevated because of a vacation payout and timing of an expense compared to last year.
- Student services is lower due to timing of advertising and promotion purchases.
- Net income through the first five months of this fiscal year shows as a loss of \$445,907.

Monthly General Fund Revenue and Expense through November 2022 (Budget to Actual Comparison)

- Library Books and equipment is up due to timing of purchases.
- All other categories are in acceptable ranges for this stage of the year except as noted above.

General Fund Month to Month Comparison through November 2022

- Outside services was higher due to various expenses including OIT, electrical instruction, legal, and maintenance.
- The Month-to-Month comparisons are tracking as expected except as noted above.
