

## REQUEST FOR BIDS

Alpena Community College is accepting bids for lawn mowing services for the 2026-2027, with an option to extend to the 27-28 mowing season if both parties agree by November 1<sup>st</sup> 2026. The successful bidder will be responsible for evaluating mowing needs of the campus depending on seasonal/weather conditions and must schedule mowing frequency as appropriate to maintain the lawn based on each priority area (see attached map). When classes are in session (August 20-May 8), we ask to avoid cutting during class times and in direct proximity to buildings.

Please include your capacity (i.e., crew size, number of mowers, and type of mowers available).

Please include references from three businesses, schools, or municipalities.

Bids will be evaluated based on references, capacity, and price.

Bagging not required – Trimming not required

- ACC reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
- Work shall meet or exceed all appropriate codes.
- Certificate of insurance required.


