




Career Coach—Our Online Career Assistant Tool

Counseling

All current ACC students (including part-time, dualenrolled and Early College students) have access to free mental health counseling. No health insurance information is needed. Financial Aid

- A FAFSA needs to be completed every year you plan on attending college.
- Most scholarships require you to complete a FAFSA. The sooner you complete the FAFSA, the more time you will have to focus on scholarship applications.
- Students should always add their local Community College to the FAFSA, even if they do not plan on attending that college. Life happens and sometimes it is best to have a backup plan. A backup plan will give you a piece of mind and ensure you may be able to start at your Community College if your initial plans do not go accordingly.
