

2025-2026 Family Size Verification Dependent Student

Your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this institutional verification document and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and a parent whose information was reported on the FAFSA must complete and sign this institutional verification document, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to us. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

B. Family Information

List the people in your contributors'/parents' family, and include:

- Yourself, the student (even if you do not live with a parent).
- Your contributors/parents listed on the FAFSA (including contributor's spouse, i.e., step-parent), even if the student does not live with a contributor/parent.
- Your contributors'/parents' other dependent children* if they live with parent or live apart due to a period of temporary absence (e.g., college enrollment) **and** the contributors/parents will **provide more than half** of their support from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.
- Other persons* if they now live with the contributors/parents, **and the contributors/parents provide more than half** of their support and will continue to provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

*The provided criteria for "dependent children" or "other persons" mirror the requirement that family size align with those the parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the parent were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of completing the 2025-2026 FAFSA. As a result, the parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.
