**Course Withdrawal Deadlines:** Individual Course Withdrawal (W Grade) is Friday, November 5. Complete Withdrawal (all courses W Grades) is Friday, December 10. For short courses (less than 16 weeks), please contact the Registrar's Office for drop/withdrawal dates.

**Early Registration** opens for Spring 2022 (returning students) on **Monday, October 25**.

**Fall Graduation Applications** were due to the Registrar's Office by **Friday, October 8**. Graduation applications are available in the Registrar's Office or on Self-Service.

**The FAFSA for the 2022-2023 school year is available starting October 1, 2021.**
