Individual Course Withdrawal (W Grade) – is March 31, 2023

Complete Withdrawal – ALL Courses (W Grades): Friday, May 5, 2023

For short courses (less than 16 weeks) – contact the Registrar's Office for drop/withdrawal dates

Using your ACC email address and password, you can log in to myACC to access Self-Service, Blackboard, and Office 365/ACC email all from one location. 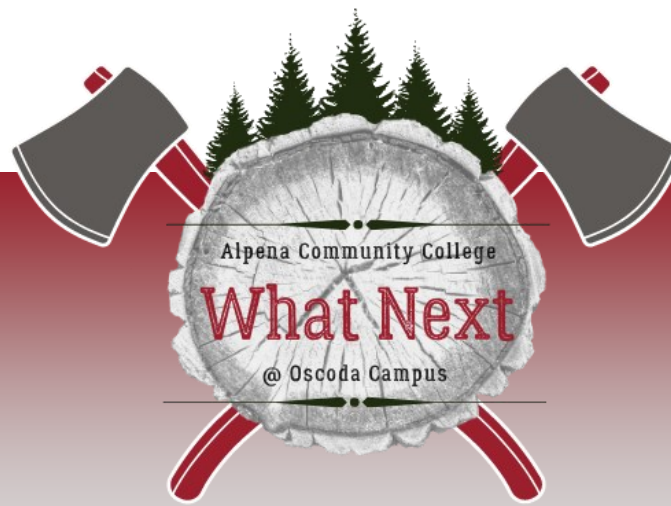

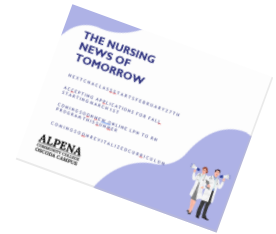
