## ACC RANKS #1 IN GRADUATION RATE AND SPRING SEMESTER ENROLLMENT INCREASE

ALPENA, MICH. — Alpena Community College is riding a wave of student success this year as shown in two recent Michigan community college metrics for success: ACC earned the highest graduation rate of all Michigan community colleges in the 2022 Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) Data Feedback Report and ACC ranks number one in enrollment increases for Spring Semester 2023.

President Dr. Don MacMaster reported the two major accomplishments at the January 19, 2023, ACC Board of Trustees meeting. In his report to the trustees MacMaster noted the following:

- As of January 17, 2023, Spring semester enrollment at ACC was up 12.35% in headcount, first among Michigan community colleges by a wide margin. Credit hours increased by 7.55%. Enrollment was up on main campus, Oscoda Campus, at other sites, and for online/remote courses. Dual enrollment was up substantially.
- As of January 19, ACC's increase in headcount had risen to 13.95% and credits had increased to 8.69%, both of which were first among Michigan community colleges as reported by the Michigan Community College Student Services Association enrollment report.
- The 2022 Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) report was released recently; it showed that ACC finished first in graduation rate (42%) among Michigan's community colleges.
